### 1. Minutes of 2014 meeting (Bern)

The minutes are approved and ML is thanked.

### 2. Budget

There are years where we produce one SPELL volume and years where we publish two. This means that we are alternately in the black or in the red with the SAUTE finances. 2014 is a year where we are in the black. There are 153 dues payments by registered members. Three people paid extra into the travel fund (an additional 220 CHF). In December 2014, the balance was 40'992 CHF. See last page of the minutes for details.

### 3. Auditor's report

The auditors Thomas Austenfeld and Julia Straub and the assembly approve the finances. After 8 years in office, Thomas Austenfeld resigns from his post as auditor. The assembly thanks him for his work for the society. Rahel Orgis is nominated and approved as new auditor for SAUTE for the remaining year of the current three-year term of office.

The SPELL series is running smoothly so that no news apart from the following are reported.

SPELL 31 (2015): *Drama and Pedagogy in Medieval and Early Modern English Literature*, eds. Elisabeth Dutton and James McBain (Magdalen College, Oxford). The volume is based on a selection of papers presented at the 2014 SAMEMES conference in Fribourg.

SPELL 32 (2015): *Literature, Ethics, Morality*, eds. Philipp Schweighauser and Ridvan Askin. The volume is based on a selection of papers presented at the 2014 SANAS conference in Basel.

### *Approved at 2014 AGM*

SPELL 33 (2016): *Economies of English*, eds. Martin Leer and Genoveva Puskas. This volume will be based on a selection of papers presented at the 2015 SAUTE conference in Geneva.

### **5. Webmaster's report**

### **6. ESSU**

Due to administrative reorganisation at the English unit in Basel, we no longer have the same secretarial power to draw on. This means that the workload for ESSU has to be reorganized. For this reason, a survey was conducted as to the usefulness of the ESSU bulletin. Forty-four people responded (a mix of new and senior members). Since many members use either the printed or the electronic version of the ESSU booklet for varied reasons, and since the booklet also shows to the SAGW what the society members work on, we will continue the booklet in printed and electronic form. To save working hours, the collection of bibliographical information on member publications will now be done via an online survey platform (password protected). The Basel team will inform all members in due time when the database is ready for feeding. The assembly thanks the Basel team (Sixta Quassdorf and Miriam Locher) for their work on ESSU.

### **7. Travel awards**

Doctoral students who are SAUTE members are encouraged to apply for a SAUTE travel award of up to 500 CHF per person (deadline 1 September; see website for details). In 2014, five applications were approved by email discussion and consent: Buado, Keller, Hosbien Nisbet, Madour, Rüegg. They received 400 CHF each in order to remain within the 2'000 CHF. In the future the money for the travel fund paid by members (by 31.12. of each year) should also be added to the 2'000 CHF which have been traditionally earmarked within our internal SAUTE budget. As a consequence, the website was updated by ML as follows: "up to 2'000 plus the total amount of donations made by members to the travel fund in the previous year." This means that we can distribute 2'220 CHF in 2015.

## **9. European Society for the Study of English (ESSE)**

The ESSE 12 Conference took place in Kosice, Slovakia (August 29 to September 2, 2014) with about 700 participants from the 33 member associations and beyond. The conference showed a good balance of plenary lectures, panels and seminars in the areas of literature, linguistics and culture.

The Board Meeting was mostly devoted to routine items, such as reports from the executive, discussions of future events and decisions on book awards and bursary awards. Particularly noteworthy is the decision to go online with the European Messenger. This is an issue that has come up regularly at board meetings for the last five or ten years, but after a referendum in all the member associations (we discussed the issue at our AGM in April 2014 in Bern), it was decided to discontinue the printed version of the European Messenger. This will have positive consequences for the finances of ESSE because a substantial part of the budget regularly went into the production and mailing of the Messenger.

The next ESSE conference will take place at NUI Galway in Ireland, August 22 to 26, 2016, and the website is already up and running: <http://www.esse2016.org/>.

## **10. Biennial conferences: Neuchâtel 2017, Basel 2019**

St. Gallen was originally scheduled for 2017 but had to withdraw so that Neuchâtel will take over the 2017 organization with the topic "Change" (early to mid May). Possible speakers for literature are David Simpson (Davis, California) and for linguistics Graeme Trousdale (University of Edinburgh). Basel will host the conference in 2019. Zurich would be next in sequence but hasn't been confirmed yet.

## **11. News of doctoral programs**

As mentioned under item 5, there is now a list of doctoral programs in English studies on our website. Bern reports that it is in the process of integrating their doctoral studies into one overarching graduate school (Walter Benjamin Kolleg). The launch is going to be in early 2016. *Basel:* no news

*Bern:* Naomi Barron will visit Zurich and Bern in early October.

*Fribourg:* Emma Depledge has been hired as a new post-doctoral assistant and is currently replaced by Derek Dunne. Steve Oswald has joined the department as post-doctoral assistant in linguistics, and Sandrine Zufferey as Ambizione scholar.

*Geneva:* Simon Swift has been appointed as Professor of Modern English Literature.
